

# Recycling List of Do's and Don'ts

Belton residents are allowed to place unlimited recycling out on their collection day. Residents must place all recyclable items in the container with the blue lid. If your recycle container is full, place all other items neatly next to the container.



## Recyclable

- Aluminum cans and other metal cans
- Plastic bottles and containers with a neck #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 (look for the number inside the chasing arrow symbol). For example-
  - water bottles
  - soda/pop bottles
  - milk jugs
  - detergent bottles
  - yogurt containers
  - butter containers
- Office paper, junk mail, newspapers (without the plastic rain bag), phone books, catalogs, magazines, etc.
- Cardboard (thick corrugated and thin cereal box type), paperback books, hardback books, etc.
- Cardboard egg cartons
- Pizza delivery boxes without food
- Shredded paper in a paper bag (please label bag – *Shredded Paper*)

## Not Recyclable

- Glass (glass recycling container is available in the Belton Price Chopper parking lot)
- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Styrofoam egg cartons
- Motor oil bottles and other automotive product bottles
- Containers for household hazardous material, paint cans, etc.
- Paper towels, tissues, napkins, Styrofoam plates or cups, etc.
- Aseptic or waxed containers. For example-
  - Milk cartons
  - Juice boxes
- Gift wrap
- Photographs, blueprints, hanging file folders, etc.
- Bags that contained pet food, fertilizer, charcoal, kitty litter, etc.
