Preface

2020 – A Year of Change

The past year, 2020, has changed the world, the City of Belton and the Belton Police Department. Covid-19 has become a standard word throughout the world along with social distancing, wearing a mask and sanitizing of hands.

With that in mind, changes were made at the police department to adapt to the ever changing situations. Masks are now required in the hallways. Certain areas of the building have restricted access to minimize contamination. An Aeroclave RDS3110 sanitizing unit was acquired through Covid Relief funds. This unit is used to decontaminate the building and patrol vehicles by using a disinfective solution administered with either a wand or fog pattern. Each patrol officer is using the Aeroclave to sanitize their patrol vehicle at the end of each shift. For a time, the lobby had restricted access by the public. All public tours, citizens' academies, the ride along program etc. were also canceled during 2020 and it is expected to remain that way for at least the first part of 2021. Employees are expected to log their temperature when reporting for work. There have been numerous employees that have tested positive for Covid-19, but fortunately none that have required hospitalization.

The patrol division changed in the way they responded to calls. If possible, on report calls, a phone call would be made to the reporting party instead of having an officer respond. On calls for service or self-initiated activity, officers were required to wear a mask and when possible social distance. Warrant arrests were down due to many agencies not taking inmates due to Covid 19.

The jail checked each incoming inmate's temperature, did a Covid 19 screen and then required the inmate to wear a mask when in the main portion of the jail. The jail was fogged with the Aeroclave as needed.

The communications unit began asking Covid 19 question at the beginning of pandemic to all callers requesting police, fire or an EMS response. The Covid information was then passed on to the responding units. The communications center was sanitized each night with the Aeroclave

The procedures listed above continue at the time of this writing in an effort to minimize the police and court employees from exposure to Covid 19

On the following pages, you will see the statistics of the police department for 2020. Most numbers decreased due to the pandemic and the response of the police department to it.






