Minutes of the Belton Mayor's Task Force on Water Infrastructure

Mayor Larkey called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Members present: Mayor Larkey, Councilmember Angela Kraft, Councilmember Dave Clark, Councilmember Allyson Lawson, Stephanie Davidson, Tim Williams, Cindy Crate, Wanda Thompson

The discussion included the following items:

- Answers from last meeting
- Sources of water (water plant, river, lake, ground water)
- Forming a water/sewer district
- SRF bond for \$40 million and extending the ½ cent sales tax beyond 2027
- Pay-as-you-go plan and year 1 outcome
- Mayor Larkey's meeting with Congressman Hartzler regarding money from the federal infrastructure bill
- \$3,800 "water impact fee" for new construction
- What the city collects in water rates/debt service vs. what the city pays to KCMO for water
- Paying off the debt service fund and extending the ½ cent capital improvement sales tax via a vote
- Receiving voter approval on an SRF bond
- A desire for a no-tax or rate increase to fund the water infrastructure improvements
