My name is John Sapp. I have had the honor to serve the fire department since 1997 and as the fire chief since 2019. Our department serves The City of Belton and the areas of unincorporated Mt. Pleasant Township offering fire/rescue and EMS transport services. We respond to calls from two fire stations with fifty dedicated firefighters and support personnel who respond to approximately 6,000 calls each year. In addition to emergency response the Belton Fire Department maintains a busy schedule of training, safety inspections, public education, and fire prevention activities.
