SEWER BILLING OPTION

The City of Belton allows residential sewer customers to choose how they would like to be billed for **sewer** use.

- 1. **VOLUME METHOD**: With this method, the amount billed for sewer use is the actual number of gallons of water that month. The rate for volume method of billing is **\$1.6002** per 100 gallons of water used for residents inside the city limits.
- 2. <u>WINTER AVERAGE METHOD</u>: With this method, the amount billed for sewer use each month is the average of the actual number of gallons used in the winter months of December, January, and February. Customers that select this method are billed the same amount each month for sewer, regardless of how much or how little water is used. The winter average is recalculated annually on May 1st.

The winter average method is typically beneficial for customers that use more water during the summer months than they do during the winter months, for example, they do a lot of outside watering or they fill a swimming pool. The rate for the winter average method of billing is **§1.7213** per 100 gallons of water used for residents inside the city limits.
